New Waiting Room Chairs

The Practice has agreed to purchase additional chairs for the 2 waiting rooms. These will be suitable for patients who have particular problems getting into and out of chairs due to joint problems. The PPG and the Practice are working together to identify the most appropriate chairs.

Booking Appointments

If you have telephoned the surgery recently, you will have heard the latest recorded message to be given out. This is aimed at making patient appointments with the appropriate clinical resource, trying to free up doctor time for essential face to face appointments and trying to provide continuity of care for patients with ongoing medical conditions. The new message is below:

Welcome To the Glenfield Surgery.

To ensure continuity of your care please advise the receptionist if you are currently seeing a doctor about the condition you are calling about today.

The receptionist will be asking for a brief reason for your appointment to ensure you are signposted to the correct clinician. We are encouraging the use of telephone appointments.

Please note as from the 9th May calls to the surgery regarding blood results, scan results or general enquires will only be taken between 11.00 – 14.00

Open Access Physiotherapy Service

In June a new self referral system will be introduced for patients who believe they need physiotherapy treatment. The full details of how the system will work have not yet been released, but the general principles will be that the patient completes a self referral form, goes to our local centre (Glenfield Hospital) speaks to a clinician about their problem and if the clinician agrees waits for a physio session. Full details will be published at the Practice when they become available.
