Practice news

CQC Inspection

The formal report from CQC inspection carried out on 13 July 2017 has now been received by the Practice and is available to view on the website. Annual Flu clinic

The letters inviting patients in for the annual flu vaccination have been sent out to patients in the at risk groups. If you have not received a letter but believe you are in these groups then please contact reception. So far over 1300 appointments have been booked.

Over the next 2 – 3weeks appointments are available in September on Monday 25th, Wednesday 27th, Thursday 28th, Friday 29th, and Saturday 30th. In the early part of October appointments are available on Monday 2nd and Thursday 5th. Patients with online access to the surgery may book their appointment online.

Posters have been displayed in the surgery explaining the eligibility for the shingles vaccination.

PPG news

The Practice has asked if the PPG would consider organising some social events to give patients the opportunity to meet others. The PPG does not feel at this time that they have the resources available to undertake this. However, a local organisation exists that more than meets this need. The Glenfield U3A. The U3A has over 300 members and more than 40 interest groups. It is aimed primarily at people who have finished full time employment. The U3A has a monthly meeting at St Peter's church hall and the interest groups meet on a regular weekly or monthly basis to pursue anything that a sufficient numbers of members wish to pursue.
