Open access blood test clinics

Effective from 1st August, the open access blood test clinics is available on Wednesday and Friday mornings from 8:30am until 12:00. If you have been asked by your GP to have a blood test then simply book yourself in at Reception on either Wednesday or Friday morning and ask for a blood test. Your GP will have put your blood test details on to your record.

If you have your own blood test form from elsewhere (eg. the LRI), then ask for a blood test at Reception and tell them that you have your own form.

Payments to the Practice

If you need to make a payment to the practice, then with effect from 13th August your payment will need to be made by either a debit or credit card, (with the exception of American Express). Cash will only be accepted in exceptional circumstances.

Flu vaccination clinics

The flu vaccination programme is due to start in the last week of September. Letters will shortly be sent to patients in the 'at risk categories' inviting them in for vaccination. You are strongly advised to take up this invitation.

3000 vaccinations will be delivered to the practice between 14th September and 2nd October.
