Healing Little Hearts Charity Fundraising Update

As you will be aware, the surgery is fundraising for the Healing Little Hearts (HLH) charity. The charity performs heart surgery on babies and young children born with congenital heart disease. Founded in 2007, HLH sends teams of doctors and nurses to some of the poorer countries in the world to carry out these life changing operations. To countries such as India, Kenya, Tanzania, Mauritius, Malaysia and Romania where families are often unable to afford the medical costs or the facilities and skills to carry out the surgery do not exist. To date, over 1600 operations have been performed.

The medical teams give their time voluntarily, the funds are required to cover travel and accommodation costs.

On 28th April 2019, Dr Chotai, along with others, is undertaking the Leicestershire 3 Peaks challenge. This walk, of about 16 miles, climbs 3 of the highest peaks in Leicestershire, namely, Bardon Hill, Beacon Hill and Old John in Bradgate Park.
