## Glenfield Defibrillator - do you know where it is?

It is estimated that around 100,000 people die from Sudden Cardiac Arrest in the UK each year and, while CPR saves the lives of around 9%, if CPR is used alongside a defibrillator the chance of survival increases to 50%

There is a defibrillator situated at the Glenfield Co-op petrol station on the wall next to the cash machine and 2 council owned defibrillators locally. The council defibrillators are located by the front entrance to the Parish Council offices at Park House and the other at the Gynsills Lane Sports Club on Gynsills Lane.

If the defibrillator is ever needed, anyone can call 999 and the emergency operator will pass on a code that will open the locked case that it is stored in.

### **Annual Patient Experience Survey**
