Flu vaccination programme

Over 4,000 letters have been sent out to 'at risk' patients inviting them to attend the surgery for an influenza vaccination. This group of patients includes those aged over 65, those with long term conditions such as COPD and diabetes, and pregnant ladies. These clinics run through until the 1st November. Whilst a number of patients have had their vaccination a significant number still have to make their appointments and attend the surgery. Patients are strongly advised to have the vaccination and to contact the surgery as soon as possible to make an appointment.

Staff changes

The practice is hosting 2 first year Physician Associate (PA) students from 4th October 2019 until end of February 2020. The students will be at the surgery each Friday and have an observation role.

ECG referrals to Glenfield hospital.

Glenfield hospital has a walk-in clinic for ECG testing. If you are referred for a test by your GP, you will be pleased to know that the hours of the clinic have been extended. The clinic is now open from 8:30am – 4:30pm Monday to Friday.

Engage Consult

Engage Consult is powerful online application which allows the patient to submit questions about their health and for the practice to get back to the patient in the most appropriate manner, eg. email, telephone, make appointment for a consultation and so on. Some of you will remember a while back that the practice installed **AskmyGP** which covered similar aspects to Engage Consult. On that occasion the practice was totally swamped with questions

Initially, training will be given to the Administrative staff and the first phase will allow patients to make enquiries about such things as advice on vaccinations for foreign travel. When the system is available in a few weeks time, patients will need a separate online sign in to access the system. We will keep you posted with progress.
