# **Open Access Blood Clinic**

The Open Access Blood Clinic which operates on a Wednesday morning has now been extended. A further clinic is available, for a trial period, on Thursday mornings. Both these clinics are open from 8:30am until 12:15pm. You just need to turn up, tell the receptionist that you have been asked to have a blood test and then wait your turn. If your doctor has asked you to have a blood test then the information will be on the system. If you have been asked to have a blood test by someone else, for example the hospital, then you will need to bring the blood test form that was given to you by them.

# **New Waiting Room Chairs**

The Practice has agreed to purchase additional chairs for the 2 waiting rooms. These will be suitable for patients who have particular problems getting into and out of chairs due to joint problems.

### **Automatic Doors**

The Practice has agreed to the installation of automatic doors at the main entrance the surgery. The 'heavy' doors at the surgery entrance have been an issue for a number of years, so it is welcome news to know that something will be done about the situation. Quotes are being sought for the various options and we will update you as soon as we have further news.

### **Booking Appointments**

Some of you will have heard the recorded message when you telephone for an appointment. The message advises you that you will be asked for a brief reason why you want the appointment. This is so that your appointment can be made with the most appropriate clinician; be that doctor, nurse etc. If you do not wish to give a brief reason for your appointment then you will be offered a telephone consultation only. This change has been made to make more effective use of clinical staff time and avoid situations of patients seeing the doctor when the nurse can competently deal with their problem.
